Waukesha JanBoree

The 26th Annual Waukesha JanBoree takes center stage January 21st through the 23rd. This city-wide event boasts more than 30 free children's activities with many of them taking place right here in historic downtown Waukesha.

The celebration downtown begins with a special edition of **Freeman Friday Night LIVE!** Enjoy this popular music event for the opening night of JanBoree as you take in live music from 6 to 8 p.m.

On Saturday, ride the trolley from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and find out why it's all about the ice!

Come downtown for the **ice sculpting competition**, from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m., when the pros turn 300 pound blocks of ice into works of art. Pick up your list of carving locations at Generations at 5 Points, 294 W. Main St.

Also on Saturday, kids can challenge themselves in the **Waukesha Sunrise Rotary Penguin Egg Hunt** at Cutler Park, 321 Wisconsin Ave where the children look for candy filled eggs in the snow left by the penguin himself. Ages 3 and under are at noon. And ages 4 & 5 are at 12:15.
